




Q3 Which	gender	do you	identify	with?
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

### Q4 Is the gender you identity with the same as your sex registered at birth?






# Q6 Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?





#### Q7 What is your ethnic group?









### Q11 Did either of your parents or guardian(s) attend university by the time you were 18?





### Q12 What was the occupation of your main household earner when you were about 14?




