

Q3 Which gender do you identify with?





Q4 Do you consider your own gender identity to be different from that associated with your sex as registered at birth?







Q9 What is your sexual orientation?







Q11 If you went to University (to study a BA, BSc course or higher), were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?




