



#### Q3 Which gender do you identify with?





# Q4 Do you consider your own gender identity to be different from that associated with your sex as registered at birth?











#### Q9 What is your sexual orientation?







# Q11 Did either of your parents or guardian(s) attend university by the time you were 18?






